Award Application Steps

- Submit cover letter with a brief synopsis of academic training, any food industry experience, and/or research experience and career interests and goals to Dr. Kim Morgan, VP Richardson-Applebaum Scholarship Award Fund kimorgan@ufl.edu by July 31, 2021.
- Submit letter of recommendation from your department head and/or college dean goals to Dr. Kim Morgan, VP Richardson-Applebaum Scholarship Award Fund, to kimorgan@ufl.edu by July 31, 2021.
- Applicants are limited to applying only once and subsequent submissions will be not be considered. Only one submission will be accepted per university each year
